I. CALL TO ORDER

III. OFFICER'S REPORT

A. Treasurer's Report

per Clarisa Santos checking account balance per bank thru April 19th is: \$8,110.54.

IV. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Carl's Jr. Booklets: Annette will meet with Coach Tag to distribute 300 more Carl's Jr. Booklets to Freshmen and ½ of the total will go towards the individual player's cleats.
- B. Celebrity Basketball Game: Coach Tag will double check with Annie, ASB Director to confirm everything is scheduled for June 9th at 7:30 p.m. as planned. Admission will be \$5.00 per person and tickets will be sold through ASB. Annette has hired two referees at \$100.00 each for the night. Boosters will set up a snack bar and will ask parents for donations.
- C. Parent Meeting: Coach Tag has schedule first parent meeting for June 20th for all incoming freshmen interested in playing football. During the meeting Champaign letter and OC register Fundraises will be explained and distributed to each player. Program information will be explained (Fair Share Donations and pride packs). If fair share donation is paid on Meeting day 6/20/16 freshmen will receive a free cinch bag.
Pride Packs: 50 pride packs will be purchased and available for purchase for incoming freshmen.
- D. Football Season Budget: Coach Tag - budget attached in meeting minute binder.
- E. Ads – New Scoreboard: no new updates as to when the new scoreboard will be up. Boosters plan to sell to advertisement time to the public, businesses and alumni ads to be uploaded at each home game. Prices discussed were as follows: One time ads for homecoming proposals (special invites) \$25.00 and shout outs \$10.00 Business ads will run all season at \$300.00 Connie will get more information on the video clip process and will present to boosters.
- F. Snack Bar: Greenville Elementary snack bar fundraiser, Saturday, March 26th was successful and brought in \$1,268.93.

V. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Jaguar Prowl 5K Run/Walk – May 28th check in 6am. Players are asked to participate. \$15 for kids and \$20 for adults (19+). Registration is now open www.active.com. Part of the proceeds come back to the Football program
- B. Poker Night: scheduled for July 23rd. Planning for about 50. Boosters will begin asking for Basket Donations from parents. Each basket will have a theme; any additional things will be purchased by Boosters.
- C. Merchandise – Stadium T-shirts (Printed to include Game schedule). 1000 shirts will be ordered; it will cost the program \$5 for each shirt and in turn each player is asked to sell 10 shirts each at \$10 each. Additional merchandised that was discussed, sweatshirts, t-shirts, hats, and decal (Tag will work on a design and present and next meeting) to be sold at home games.
- D. Godinez Game – Tacos will be added to the snack bar menu for this game. Omar will purchase the meat.
- E. Smoker – Consideration of purchasing a smoker (about \$350) to help raise snack bar sales. Looking into meat prices (tri-tip) to figure out budgets and possible profit or loss.
